



Reporting a Cybersecurity Event Flowchart

If you are a "licensee" as defined in La. R.S. 22:2503(7), proceed through the chart. If not, you do not need to report.

Are you a Louisiana domestic insurer or resident producer, adjuster or public adjuster?

Does the cybersecurity event relate to the nonpublic information of 250 or more consumers residing in Louisiana?

Is there a reasonable likelihood of material harm to a consumer residing in Louisiana or material harm to part of your normal operations?

And one of the following:
A. Are you required to provide notice of the cybersecurity event to any government body, self-regulatory agency or any other supervisory body pursuant to state or federal law?
B. Is there a reasonable likelihood of material harm to a consumer residing in Louisiana or material part of your normal operations?

Required to Report. File Cybersecurity Event Report with LDI within 3 business days.
